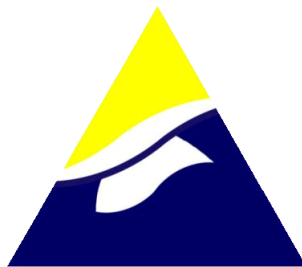

2. **C:\wap_artena** is the root folder where all files necessary to run Artena are located.

Architecture

Artena Help Documentation consists of a Help Viewer application and help content.

- The Help Viewer application is integrated within Artena.
- The Help Content consists of a number of HTML files and related resources.

Installation

1. Artena Help Documentation Setup

1.1. Layout

Artena Help Documentation is installed within an existing Artena setup.

This means that a Web Server with PHP (WAP) is already setup and working, and the Artena website has been created and configured to use it.

C:\wap_artena\artena\public\helpViewer\docs contains the Artena Help Documentation files.

1.2. Unpacking the Release

Delete all existing files and folders within **C:\wap_artena\artena\public\helpViewer\docs**

Extract the package to the following folder **C:\wap_artena\artena\public\helpViewer\docs**. This should result in the Artena Help Documentation folders and files created or updated as illustrated in the screenshot below.
