1. Artena 09.12.02 requires:
 - a. WAP 06.00.00
2. It is recommended that you use the following versions:
 - a. ArtenaSCE 01.04.01
 - b. ArtenaHelpDoc 01.11.00
 - c. ArtenaBI 01.01.01; Reporter 01.02.04
 - d. ArtenaREST 01.01.00 access given on request
 - e. Moodle Local Plugin 2016112100
3. Read the documentation for ALL releases from the release you are upgrading from:
 - a. Release Notes
 - b. Web Server and PHP Setup Guide 2
 - c. Artena Deployment Guide 2; NOTE: configuration options have been updated and new ones added
4. Compare the .DIST files for updates.
5. Security Administrator
 - a. Refer to specific changes in the release notes
 - b. To ensure the Security Administrator is compatible with Artena, delete the old version and install the new version.
6. Artena Reports

7. Maintenance
 - a. Database Size

- i. Trial SDR records are causing databases to grow dramatically in size. After marking your final files as having been successfully submitted, you must remove your trial SDR runs so that the backup and performance of Artena is maintained.
- b. NSI REST interface
 - i. Before you can use the NSI REST interface, please contact the Education Service Desk at service.desk@education.govt.nz or 0800 422 599 and request that they enable the REST interface for your organisation in NSI.
 - ii. You will need to advise them of your MoE Provider number, as well as advising them that the Go-Live process has been completed by your vendor, AdaptIT Australasia.
 - iii. Please note, if the REST interface is not enabled in NSI for your organisation you will not be able to access the NSI when you upgrade Artena-09.12.00.
 - iv. NSI SOAP interface is being decommissioned on Monday 13 March 2017, you must have upgraded to Artena-09.12.00 prior to this date.
- c. Preferences defaulting to a Subject Area
 - i. When logging into Artena for the first time the default subject area will be the first in the list. To default the Preferences Subject Area to 'Not Applicable', update the display order in the Lookup_SubjectArea.

3. New Functionality

3.1 Artena Student Portal

The Artena Student Portal has been redesigned to work seamlessly across desktops, mobile and tablets with a modernised look and feel for the students. Utilising a responsive HTML5 design to provide multi-platform support across Android, iOS and Windows devices it uses the existing backend structure and transfer mechanism developed for the initial ArtenaSP (aka SWArtena).

The redeveloped ArtenaSP includes:

- Login and Logout (network credentials (LDAP) or a portal ID and password)
- Submit personal details change
- Submit address changes (Home, Work and Term)
- View enrolment details
- View assessments
- View academic Records
- View finances
- Submit re-enrolment
- Submit general enquiry
- Provide feedback
- Resources (web links)
- Progress on requests

Why Change?	After updating a Debtor ID and performing a Client search, the expected value is not being displayed.
What Changed?	Updated the process for selecting the required information.

#16363 Class ID	
Why Change?	To provide a conversion of a Class ID to groups during the Moodle conversion.
What Changed?	Added a conversion for the mapping of Artena classes to Moodle groups.

Why Change?	Verification data from NSI is not always being displayed.
What Changed?	Amended fields displayed on return of data from the NSI.

#18047 Disability Type	
Why Change?	Correct the display of the XML value passed to Artena.
What Changed?	Corrected the display of the disability XML value in Online Enrolments.

4.5 Prescribed

#15877 Offering	
Why Change?	To allow an update to the course ID when offering a new Prescribed Teaching course with units individually or selecting 'Select all'.
What Changed?	The selection logic was modified.

#17333 Edit Courses	
Why Change?	Editing the Credit Value of a Child Course of a Programme is not being saved.
What Changed?	Updated the save process to return the correct record version indication to the client.

4.6 Public Trust

#15589 Permanent Resident	
Why Change?	Students with permanent residency are incorrectly reported as international students in the Public Trust file export.
What Changed?	The classification of a student with permanent residency and of a student with citizenship or permanent residency of Australia is treated as not International for reporting to Public Trust.

4.7 Study Contract

#16380 Add Components	
Why Change?	The process of adding Study Contract Components to a completed study contract is not consistent between Study Contract & Admissions Dashboard.
What Changed?	The requirements for a component to be added via Admissions dashboard have been updated to be consistent with the Study Contract process.

#17895 Funding Source	
Why Change?	Selecting Funding source 33 results in scroll bars on the SC Funding Source field which makes the information unreadable.
What Changed?	The scroll bars were disabled.

4.8 Study Contract

#15642 EFTS	
Why Change?	Funding Code 11 and 12 default to DOM FCR incorrectly for International Students.
What Changed?	Updated defaults: * If the Student is defined as Domestic the EFTS default to DOM FCR when the funding code is 11 or 12. * If the Student is not defined as Domestic the EFTS default to INT FCR when the funding code is 11 or 12.

	Note: If the Student transitions from International to Domestic there will be no impact on existing Study Contracts.

#17848 RSS Feed	
Why Change?	RSS feeds do not always display the expected information.
What Changed?	A mismatch in xml tags was corrected to allow the feeds to display correctly.
